**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF A
STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

On 22nd January 2007 Swindon Borough Council adopted its Statement of Community Involvement. The Statement of Community Involvement sets out how the Council will involve the community in the preparation and revision of all the planning documents that comprise its Local Development Framework, and in the consideration of the planning applications it receives.

The Statement of Community Involvement is available for public inspection, free of charge, at Swindon Borough Council Customer Services at Premier House, Station Road, Swindon and Wat Tyler House, Beckhampton Street, Swindon (Monday to Friday 9:00am to 4:30pm). The Statement of Community Involvement may also be viewed at all libraries within the Swindon Borough Council area (during the normal opening hours of those libraries) and on the Council's website at www.swindon.gov.uk

Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision of the Council to adopt its Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the day on which the document was adopted
