GALLERY RULES

Intel is a multicultural and diverse environment, and as such it is essential that any subject matter is suitable for exhibiting within the foyer. The following guidelines are to enable you as an exhibitor to select the correct material for display, as we do not wish to offend or upset any of our employees or visitors to the site.

Please consider the following criteria when you are choosing pieces for your exhibition:

- Nudity is not acceptable however tasteful.
- Subject matter depicting detailed war scenes or battles may be considered offensive.
- Goya-esque subject matter or any subject portraying inhumanity towards any living thing is not acceptable (Fox-hunting may be your passion but it will possibly offend some of our employees).
- Avoid any subject matter depicting controversial political issues or religious issues.

Please bear in mind that this is a guideline, we do not wish to completely limit your subject matter to flowers and landscapes and ask that you use common sense in this matter.

- The Gallery is located inside the Intel premises, close to the main entrance and is not accessible to the general public. Several hundred Intel employees and visitors pass through the gallery every month.
- Exhibitions are usually held for one month.
- Exhibition changeover usually takes place during the week-end (installing on Sunday and taking down on Saturday) or after working hours. Please discuss with a member of the Art Committee to find a suitable time.
- Work should not have thick (deep) frames - just so that it does not get knocked off the wall, especially in the corridor.
- The work should be framed and strung for hanging (we have hooks). Unframed deep edged gallery canvasses with clean edges are acceptable.
- You can put the works up for sale. In this case, please indicate the price and how the purchaser can contact you (phone number, email address). You will have to handle the sale directly.
- Intel is **not taking any commission** for the sale of any of your works.
- If you are not an Intel employee you will need to be escorted at all times when on the premises. Please ensure that you arrange a meeting time with an Art Committee member to enable you to gain access to the building when installing and taking down your exhibition.

IMPORTANT: the building insurance doesn't cover any work - nothing has ever been stolen, and the security do keep a look out, but small work could walk. At least one frame has been broken in the past. **Intel cannot accept any liability for stolen items or breakage.**
