#### NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF THE SWINDON CORE STRATEGY – REVISED PROPOSED SUBMISSION DRAFT (REGULATION 27) AND SWINDON DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT POLICIES – REVISED PROPOSED SUBMISSION DRAFT (REGULATION 27)

Swindon Borough Council has published the 'Revised Proposed Submission Drafts' of the Swindon Core Strategy and the Swindon Development Management Policies Development Plan Documents (DPD's). The Core Strategy is a document that sets out a spatial framework for development within the Borough. The Development Management Policies DPD is a document that sets out issue specific policies to enable the determination of proposals and support the wider strategy document. When adopted the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD's will form part of the Swindon Borough Local Development Framework.

Copies of the documents, the accompanying Sustainability Appraisal (SA) supporting technical studies and other relevant information used to inform the document are available for public inspection at Swindon Borough Council Customer Services at Wat Tyler House, Beckhampton Street, Swindon free of charge (Monday to Friday 8.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.). The Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD's and the Sustainability Appraisal may also be viewed at all libraries within Swindon Borough, during normal opening hours of those libraries, and can also be viewed on the Borough's website, where a representation form can also be downloaded, at: <http://www.swindon.gov.uk/corestrategy>

Representations should only be made to the legal compliance and 'soundness' of the Core Strategy and whether the correct procedures have been taken in its preparation. Representations should specify in what respect(s) the document is considered to be unsound, and what change(s) would need to be made to make it sound.

You may also fax your response to arrive no later than the above time and date on 01793 466459, or by e-mail to [forwardplanning@swindon.gov.uk](mailto:forwardplanning@swindon.gov.uk) no later than the above time and date, or via Swindon Borough Council's website, using the on-line comments form.

Following the consultation, the Council will submit the Core Strategy to the Secretary of State for an independent examination by a Government Planning Inspector.
