Portable Soundfields

The HST have 4 portable Soundfield systems that are available, where appropriate on a 6 week loan trial to settings.

Please be aware due to budget constraints systems cannot generally be provided by the HST for long-term use in the same way as we provide radio aids. The Soundfields benefit the whole class and staff.

They can be purchased from the manufacturers for about £1000 and we already have settings who have funded their purchase through various routes.

Please let your Advisory Teacher of the Deaf know if you would be interested in borrowing a system.
