

Swindon Short Break to Torun, Poland Proposed for November 2005



Torun, the birthplace of the great astronomer Copernicus, is a beautiful medieval city located on the bank of the River Vistula, 3-4 hours from Warsaw.

A World Heritage site that hasn't changed for centuries, Torun's old town boasts many fine examples of gothic architecture and several interesting historic sights.

Take in the panoramic beauty of the illuminated medieval part of the city from the Vistula River side, visit the house where Nicolaus Copernicus was born and enjoy Torun's other popular attractions including the silent arches of St. John's Cathedral, the tomb of princess Anna Wazówna in Saint Mary church, the Town Hall and of course, the Planetarium.
