



Flux Register of Interest for Artists

Background

FLUX is a three year programme delivering arts activities to children and young people in north Swindon. Managed by Artsmad, it is funded through the Treasury's Invest To Save budget.

Flux is an action research project which puts arts investment at the start of a new education facility, linked to the growth of a large urban housing development. The Arts are used proactively to address causes, not outcomes, of disaffection, disengagement and anti-social behaviour. Flux will investigate the effect that pre-emptive, inter-disciplinary arts interventions can have in shaping new communities, learning facilities and young lives.

Flux is based in Isambard Community School, a brand new secondary school in the heart of a large new community in north Swindon. Key elements of the Flux programme include: procurement and design of a state-of-the-art mobile film studio, delivery of an innovative arts curriculum by a large team of professional artists, partnership work and arts residencies across all the schools in the neighbourhood and a programme of arts activities in youth and community settings.

Through the delivery of the arts programme Flux will be contracting individual artists and organisations across all artforms to run workshops, residencies and projects.

Flux is keen to build a database of community artists who have experience of working in a range of community settings with children and young people.
