### Project Update

Although things will have appeared to gone quiet over the last few months, work has been continuing behind the scenes. Westlea Housing Association are in the process of the final tender for these works and a construction company will be appointed shortly with a view of a start on site in late August / early September 2008. Once a construction company has been appointed a detailed phasing plan for the building works will then be drawn up.

As promised, prior to the commencement of the works a public meeting for all local residents about the regeneration project will be held in John Moulton Hall. Present at this meeting will be Council Officers, representatives from Westlea Housing Association and the appointed construction company. A date for the public meeting will announced once a construction company has been appointed and the phasing plan drawn up.

The Council will ensure that during the regeneration of Braydon Court the building works will be phased to enable local shops to be open throughout. This means amenities such as the post office and groceries will be available for the duration of the works. We hope this will cause as little inconvenience and disruption as possible whilst these works are taking place.
