- A) There will not be any facilities for car boot sales, but there will be the new improved premises for Parks Advice Point, Credit Union, The Shop, the Library, improved access and facilities for Reuben George Social Hall, improved school facilities (with some public access), open space with play area.
- Q) Will all the facilities be fully accessible for wheelchairs, pushchairs etc
- A) Yes all the facilities be fully accessible for wheelchairs, pushchairs etc
- Q) Will there be facilities for over 50's social events, e.g. tea dances
- A) There will be improved access and facilities for Reuben George Social Hall where the first floor hall will remain but have greater capacity
- Q) Is it possible to have some sort of notice letting people who do not live in the area know that business as usual is the case
- A) A business as usual sign listing all the names of the shops is being considered
