Scene One

Reach Inclusive Arts: What do we do?

Reach Inclusive Arts (RIA) creates opportunities for people, of all ages with a range of disabilities, including learning difficulties, physical disabilities, sensory impairment, people who use mental health services, those who are isolated and others disadvantaged in society, to experience a range of artistic mediums.
