Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2021 (Variation No 2) Order 2024

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following requests from Brunel Academies Trust as a result of the development of School on Walsingham Road, this order seeks to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time), & No stopping on entrance markings (School Keep Clear)

The requests are as a consequence of parking and visibility difficulties encountered on Walsingham Road as a result of parked vehicles

Therefore to address the concerns raised Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and recommends the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time, & No Stopping on entrance markings.

The reason for making this order is as follow;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; or
- b. For preventing damage to the road or to any building on or near the road; or
- c. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- d. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs, or
- e. to assist with the free flow of traffic,
- f. to improve the environment for local residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with residents and emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
