

PUBLIC NOTICE

SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(RAINSCOMBE ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES)
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2024

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that Swindon Borough Council made the above Experimental Order under the relevant sections of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which comes into effect on the 8 April 2024 for a period of 18 months the effect of which will be to designate a section of Rainscombe Road as a school street. Vehicles will be prohibited to enter and proceed on Rainscombe Road, from the junction with Salthrop Rise for a distance of 192.3 metres in a north westerly and north easterly direction finishing at the junction of Homington Avenue, as indicated by signs, Monday to Friday 8:15am to 9:00am and 2.30pm to 3.15pm.

Access for residents will be maintained by the introduction of a school street permit scheme. Access to the properties in the restricted area to be maintained for the delivery/collection of goods/services and passengers.

Statutory exemptions to emergency services and other vehicles used by the Council and utilities to be maintained.

The Experimental Order is introduced to allow the Council to implement the restrictions on a trial basis.

Any person wishing to make representations whether to object to or support the Order before it is made permanent must do so by completing the consultation form which can be found at www.swindon.gov.uk/trafficregulationorders under 'experimental traffic regulation orders' reference (ST/TRO/School Street, Rainscombe Road) by no later than 8 October 2024. Any objection or representation received will form part of a public record which may be made publicly available.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 27 March 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
