## STATEMENT OF REASONS

Swindon Borough Council has been asked to consider introducing a 20mph Speed Limit on the following roads, Bryony Way, Bayleaf Avenue, Fennel Close, Avens Close, Hylder Close, Buckthorn Drive, Clover Park, Saffron Close, Jasmine Close, Nutmeg Close, Basil Close, Catmint Close, Loveage Close, Mint Close, Comfrey Close, Angelica Close, Ramsthorn Close, Lichen Close, Chives Way, Marigold Close, Alder Close.

Swindon's Road Safety Strategy states that the Council will review Swindon's speed limits "to ensure they remain appropriate and enforceable. Particular attention will be given to the safety of vulnerable road users and the use of 20mph speed limits on residential streets." The intended purpose of 20mph schemes are to minimise the risk of collisions occurring and to ensure that when collisions do occur, the impacts are unlikely to result in death or serious injury.

The request has been submitted to the Council by local Ward Councillors on behalf of the local community as part of our invitation for applications for potential 20mph speed limits within the Borough
