## Chiseldon Neighbourhood Plan Referendum - Information Statement

A Referendum relating to the adoption of the Chiseldon Neighbourhood Plan will be held on **Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2025.** 

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is:

'Do you want Swindon Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Chiseldon to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

The referendum area is identified on the map which is included with this information statement.

A person is entitled to vote on the referendum if on 29th October 2025

- He or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area;
   and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A persons qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is £2,479.00 based upon 1,983 persons entitled to vote (£2,362.00 + £0.059 per elector) as at the publication of the revised register for the area. The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 1,983.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
