## Re -Parking Restrictions Stratton Road & New Dawn Place

I am writing to advise you that the Swindon Borough Council has been asked to consider introducing parking restrictions on New Dawn Place and Stratton Road

The intended purpose of the waiting restrictions is to prevent obstruction on New Dawn Place and Stratton Road junction.

This request has been submitted to the Council by Local Ward Councillors as a result of concerns raised by residents or poor parking behaviours around this junction.

Prior to Swindon Borough Council starting the statutory process, you are invited to comment on the proposals that have been prepared in conjunction with your local Ward Councillors.
