Dear Occupier/Resident,

Re – Proposed Changes to the Waiting and Loading Restrictions, Islington Street

I am writing to advise you that Swindon Borough Council has been asked to consider the proposed revocation of the No Loading At Any Time restrictions and the installation of a Blue Badge holder parking bay outside the Health Centre in Islington Street.

The proposed bay would provide 1 hour maximum stay, (no return within 1 hour) and accommodate two vehicles immediately outside the Health Centre. The adjacent areas of parking restrictions (double yellow lines) would also allow loading and unloading and use by Blue Badge holders along the front of the Health Centre.

This request has been submitted to the Council as a result of concerns raised over the need for a dedicated parking provision for Blue Badge holders accessing the Health Centre along with loading/unloading provision.

Prior to Swindon Borough Council starting the statutory Traffic Regulation Order process, you are invited to comment on the proposals that have been prepared.

Please review the plans and submit any comments you may have via the form on the website by 4 September 2026.
