

Statement of Representation Procedure

The emerging Swindon Local Plan 2043 was approved by Swindon Borough Council Cabinet (1 July 2026) and Council (6 August 2026) for publication in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.

The subject matter of the Swindon Local Plan 2043

The Swindon Local Plan 2043 will form a key part of the development plan for the Borough, setting out the strategy and policy framework to guide development and growth over the plan period. It identifies the Borough's housing, employment and infrastructure needs and where this should be located and provide guidance for the determination of planning applications.

The emerging Local Plan covers the entirety of the Borough Council's administrative area.

Period for submission of representations

The Regulation 19 publication period provides the final opportunity for residents, businesses and stakeholders to make comments on the soundness of the Local Plan before it is submitted to the Secretary of State for examination.

The period for submission of representations will last for 6 weeks and begins on Thursday 24th September 2026 and ends at **11:59pm on Thursday 5th November 2026**.

All representations must be submitted and received by the council during this time.
