- 4. AND I MAKE this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835



PERMISSIVE ACCESS

These permissive routes provide off-road links between Overtown and Barbary Castle Country Park. The routes link with the Ridgeway National Trail, crossing part of the World War II Wroughton Aerodrome.

Overtown Farm is managed for conservation purposes, aiming to protect historic features and support declining farmland birds such as corn bunting, tree sparrow, yellow wagtail, grey partridge and lapwing.
