

**Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places
Consolidation) Order 2017 (Variation No 8) Order 2018**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following requests from residents within the local area, this Order seeks to extend double yellow lines (no waiting at any time),

The requests are as a consequence of parking and visibility difficulties encountered on Mays Close as a result of parked vehicles

Therefore to address the concerns raised Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO) and recommends the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time,

The reason for making this order is as follow;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and or any other road or preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road for any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians),
- c. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs,
- d. to assist with the free flow of traffic,
- e. to improve the environment for local residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors.
