- You cannot vote at the European Parliamentary elections in more than one country. If you fill in this form, you are agreeing to vote in the UK only and not in your home country. But remember, you can cancel this registration up until **12 working days before the poll**.
- If you intend to vote in the European Parliamentary elections in your home country rather than the UK, do not complete this form.
- Completing this form does not affect your voting rights for elections other than the European Parliamentary elections, either in the UK or your home country.

- This form must reach your electoral registration office **12 working days before the poll**.

The Electoral Registration Officer will only use this information for electoral purposes. They will look after personal information securely and will follow data protection legislation. They will not give personal information about you or any personal information you may provide on other people to anyone else or another organisation unless they have to by law.

The lawful basis to collect the information in this form is that it is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest and exercise of official authority as vested in the Electoral Registration Officer as set out in Representation of the People Act 1983 and associated regulations.
