Adult Services Equality Summary 2014/15

Services to adults in Swindon gather a large amount of data about service users particularly in respect of Age, Sex, Disability and Race.

This information is used to support the Council's current priorities in response to the budget and efficiency pressures which are facing the Council. The five priorities are:

- Work with residents to create well cared for neighbourhoods
- Right skills, right jobs, in the right places
- Together, find new ways to reduce vulnerability and improve health for all
- Work with people and families to help them fulfil their potential
- Make best use of Swindon's resources inside and outside the Council

And in particular the managing adult demand work programme which identifies that the Council spends more than a third (36%) of its annual budget on vulnerable adults, amounting to £53million.

During 2014/15 we supported 5,274 people aged 18 and over. Each year 1,400 more people become reliant on social care. As we're living longer nowadays, this figure is set to rise.

The managing adults demand programme seeks to:

- Prevent crisis and maintain people's independence, supporting people to make choices about their living arrangements and do more for themselves.
- Build the capabilities and skills of communities, service users, carers and staff so people can live as independently as possible and make the most out of all resources.
- Protect the most vulnerable people in Swindon
- Live within our financial means, in the face of increasingly tight budgets.

Following the replacement of the RAP (Referrals, Assessments and Packages of Care) with the SALT return (Short and Long Term Return) in 2014/15, the main client categories have changed since the last Adult Services Equality Summary (2013/14). Additionally the definitions for inclusion in each of the data tables may have changed explaining differences between the current data and that of the 2013/14 summary.

The categories used are set by a statutory data return to the Department of Health on Referrals, Assessments and Packages of Care (this is known and referred to as RAP). This specifically requires different equality information at different stages, so there is not a consistent use of categories across the RAP data. The RAP reporting period runs from April to March and is reported in May each year. The information here is for April 2013 to March 2014. The 2014/15 information will be available in the summer of 2014.

The summary information covers the following areas:

Contacts. Contacts with the Council which may lead to an adult care assessment.

Assessments. The number of adult care assessments carried out by either SEQOL (Learning Disability, Physical Disability, Sensory Loss) or AWP (Mental Health)

Care Packages. The number of care packages in place during 2014/15 – some of these will have been on-going for a number of years and a number will have ended before the end of the year (31^{st} March 2015).

All Contacts

- All Contacts which have been recorded on SWIFT for clients and carers (new and existing), broken down by age group, ethnic group and those that progressed to an assessment.
- Not including AWP contacts. AWP record only contacts which progressed to referral. Between 1st April 2014 and 31st March 2015 this was 2696 contacts.
