

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT)  
ORDER 2015  
DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4

WHEREAS Swindon Borough Council being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4 of the GPDO, are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out within the whole of the Bishopstone Conservation Area, unless planning permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by article 4 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description(s) set out in the Schedule below:

SCHEDULE OF DEVELOPMENT AFFECTED

The development to be controlled comprises the installation, alteration or replacement of solar PV or solar thermal equipment on (a) a dwellinghouse; or (b) a building situated within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse, being development comprised within Class A of Part 14 of Schedule 2 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

This Direction will come into force on 20th March 2015.

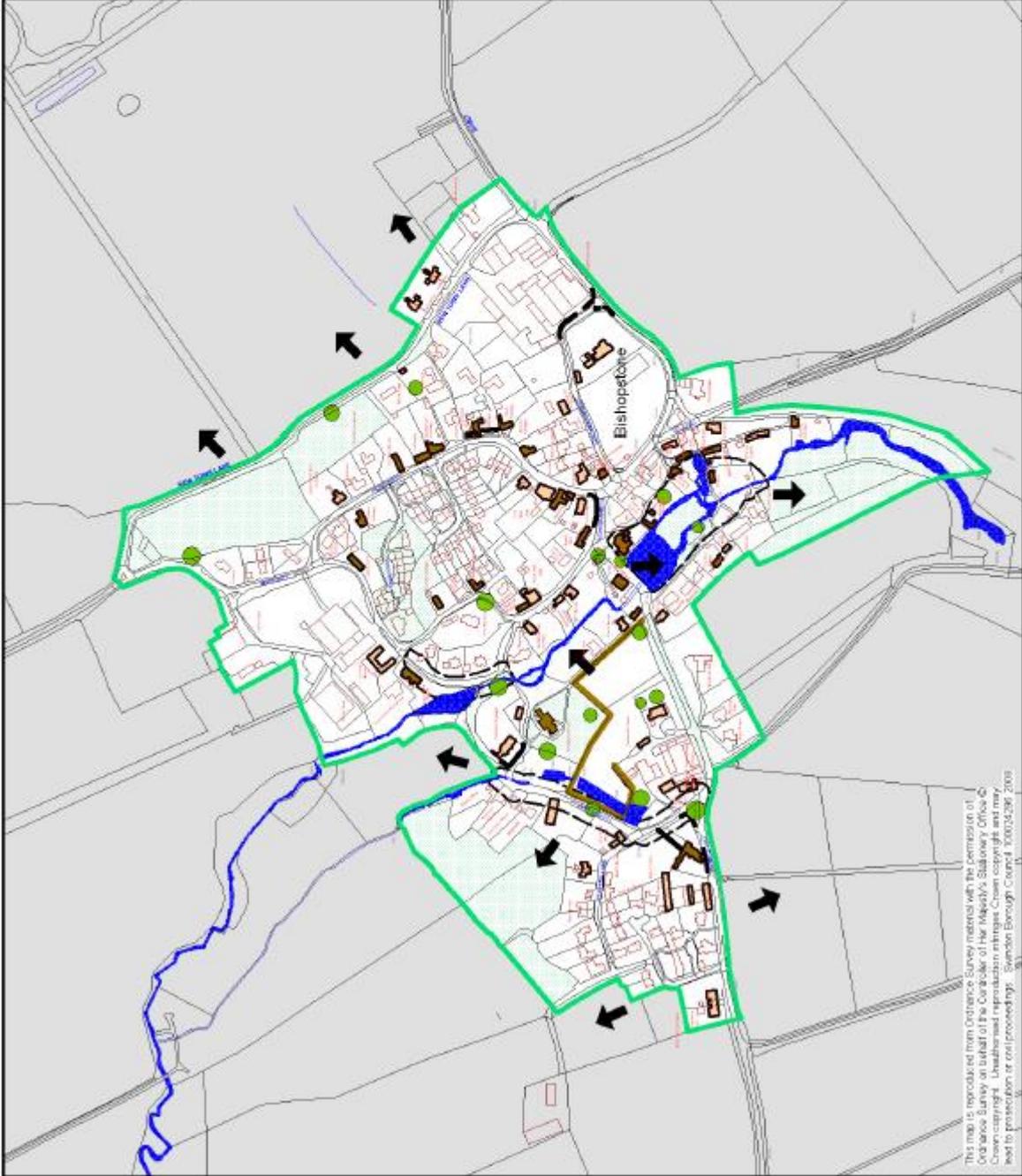
