

Social Care Equalities Monitoring: Open Cases

Headlines for open cases as at end of Q2 15/16

Compliance

- > 2 Children in need and 1 child in care with Open Cases do not have their gender recorded.
- > DOB remains at 100% for all case types (that are not unborn).
- > Religion recording remains too low to be able to draw any conclusions from the data. However, it should be noted that recording of religion for CiC is a lot higher than for CIN and CPP.
- > Disability recording for Children with a CPP was fairly consistent around 40/45%, however in Q2 this has dropped to 29.4%. *NB: Caution should be taken with these figures - the list of disabled children and whether or not disability was recorded was taken from Capita One and the Disabled Childrens Database Oct 2013. The latter is currently awaiting a refresh.*

Population

- > The gender split remains a consistent 50-50 split (within 2ppts) for CIN and CPP. However CiC have 53.7% boys and 45.9% girls (0.4% not recorded). This equates to 16 more boys and 4 less girls than in Q1 15/16.
- > The proportion of children in each age band for the 3 groups (CIN, CPP and CiC) is similar when comparing Open Cases as at 30/06/15 and at 30/09/15. CiC are more highly represented in the 16 to 19 age group. Whereas CIN and CPP are more highly represented up to the age of 9. The 10 to 15 age group is over-represented compared to the Swindon under 18 population in CIN, CPP and CiC.
- > Some ethnic groups look like they have had a large increase/ decrease in open cases, however due to small cohort sizes this often equates to only 1 or 2 children.
- > There are no notable shifts in the representation of different ethnic groups in CIN, CPP or CiC.

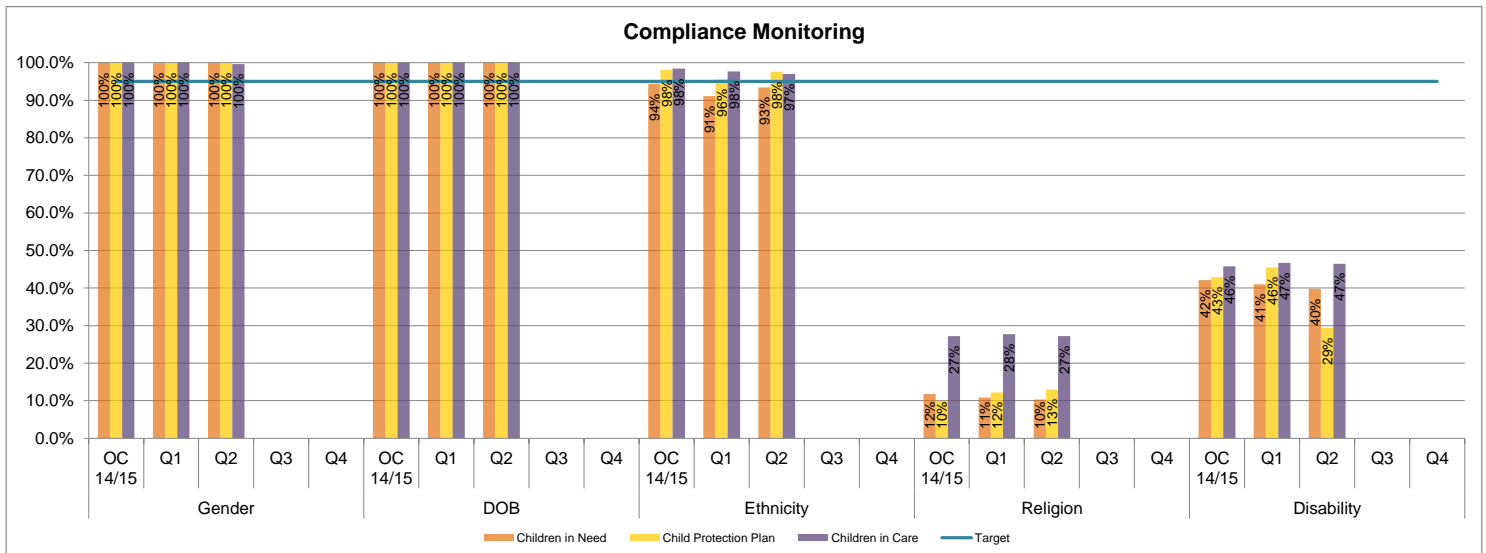

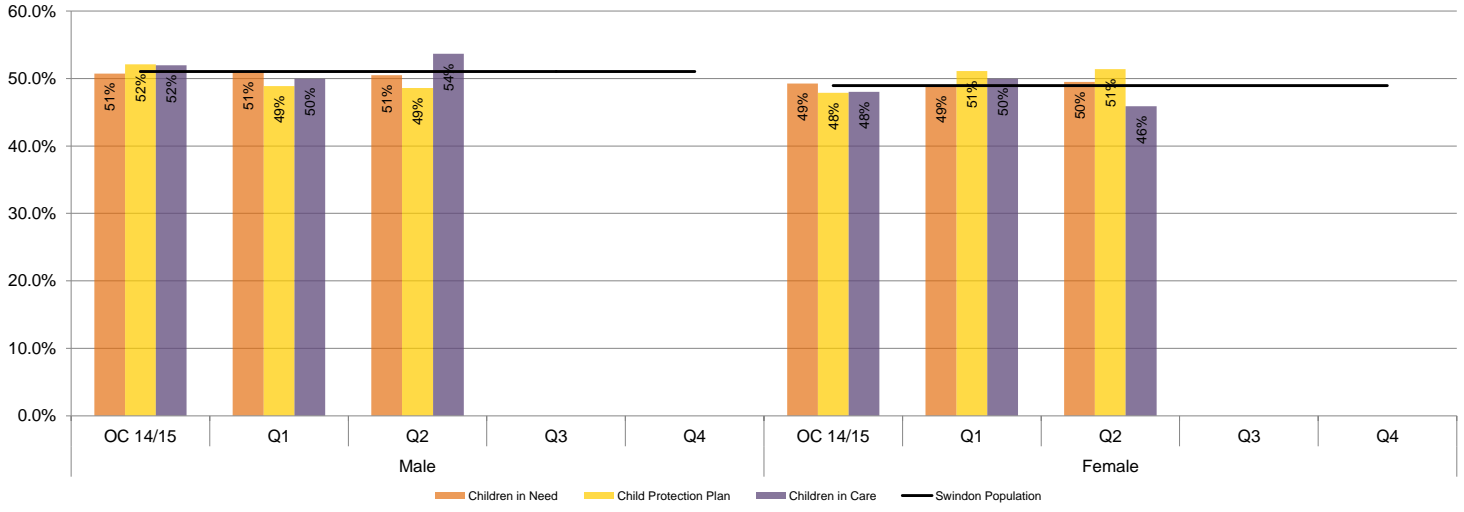

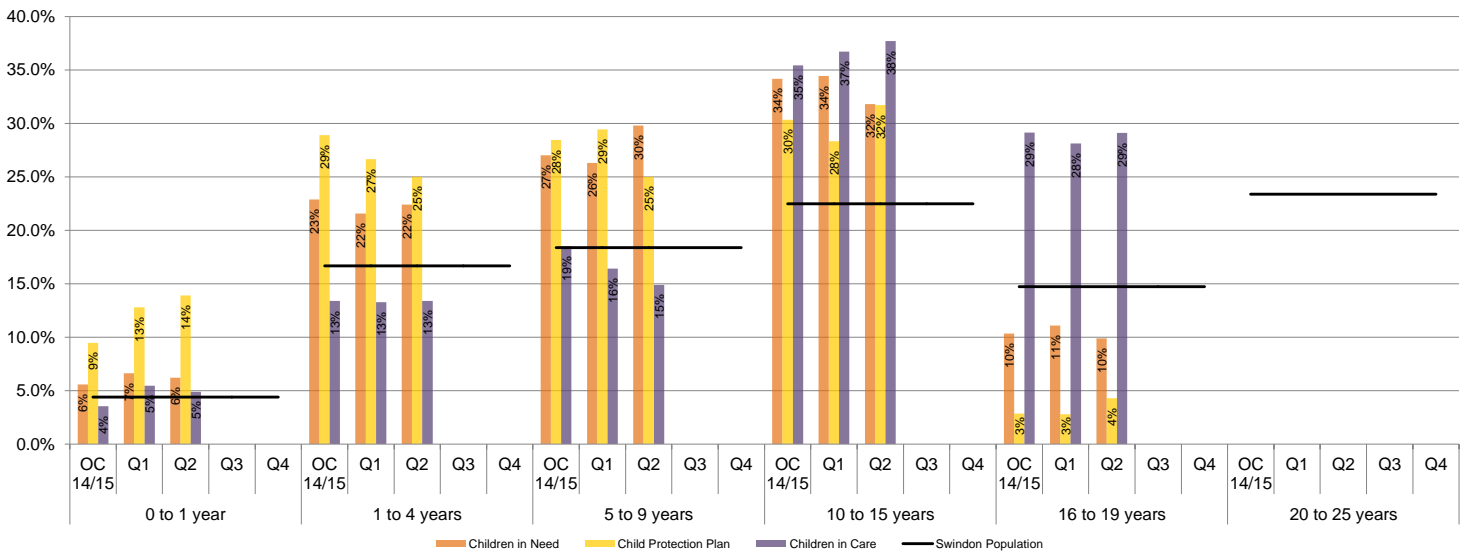

Gender Breakdown: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population



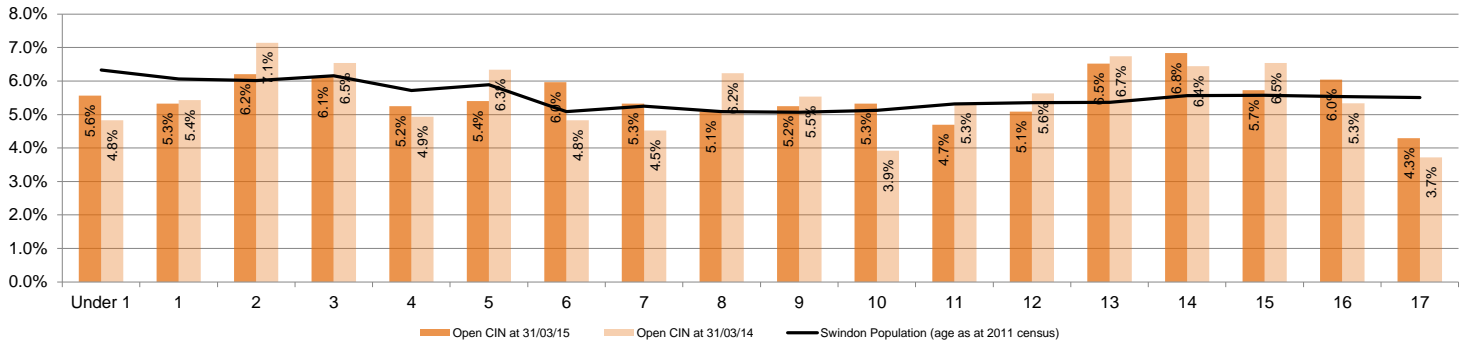

Age Breakdown: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population

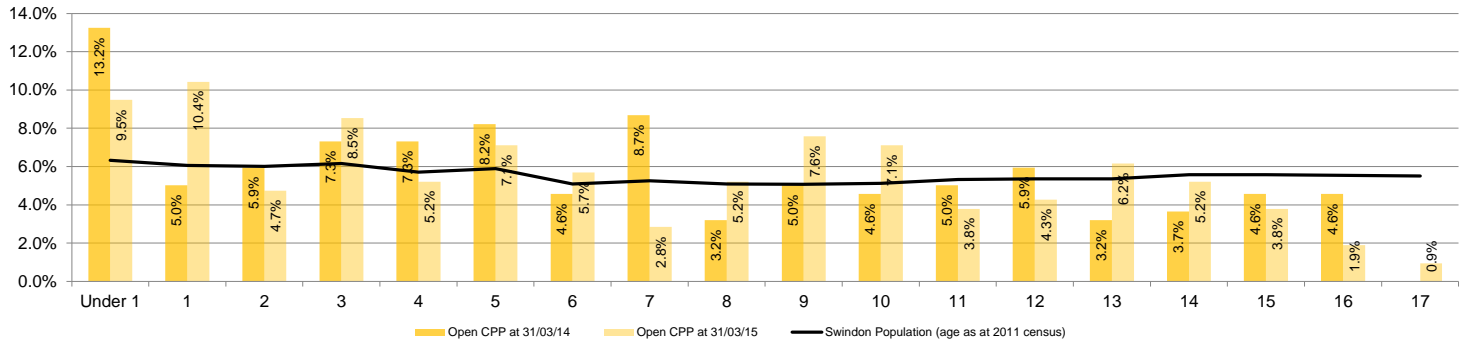

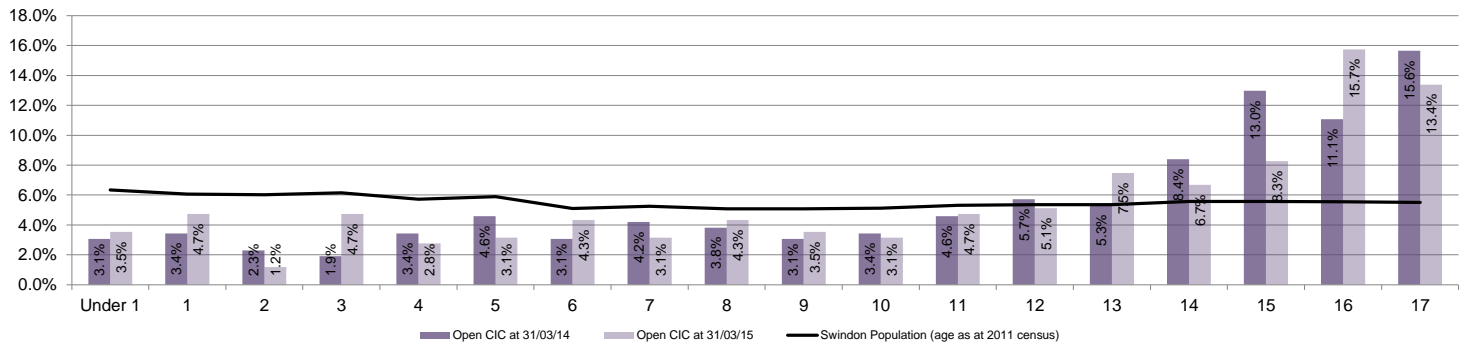
Age by single year: Open CIN cases compared with Swindon population - Annual Snapshots as at 31/03/2014 and 31/03/2015

Age by single year: Open CiC cases compared with Swindon population - Annual Snapshots as at 31/03/2014 and 31/03/2015

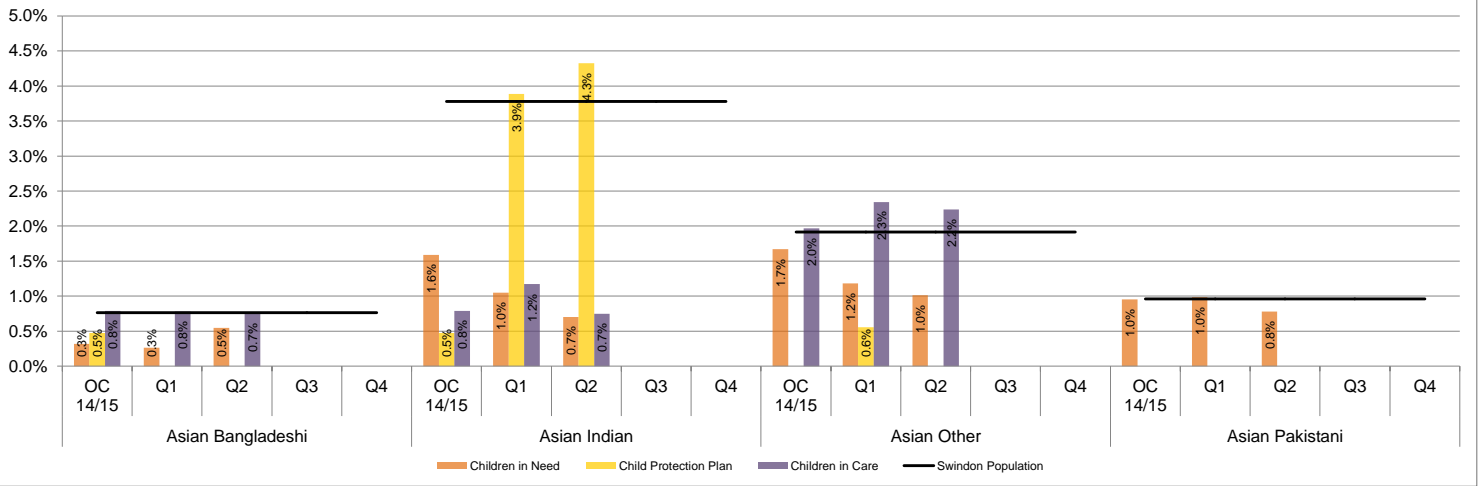

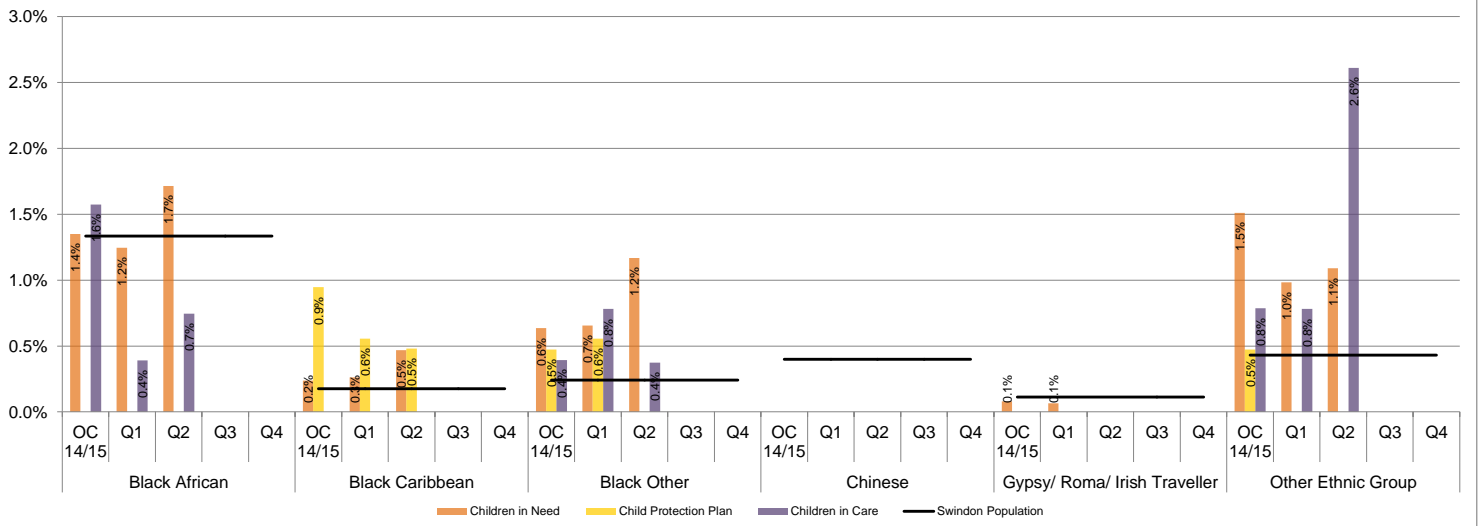

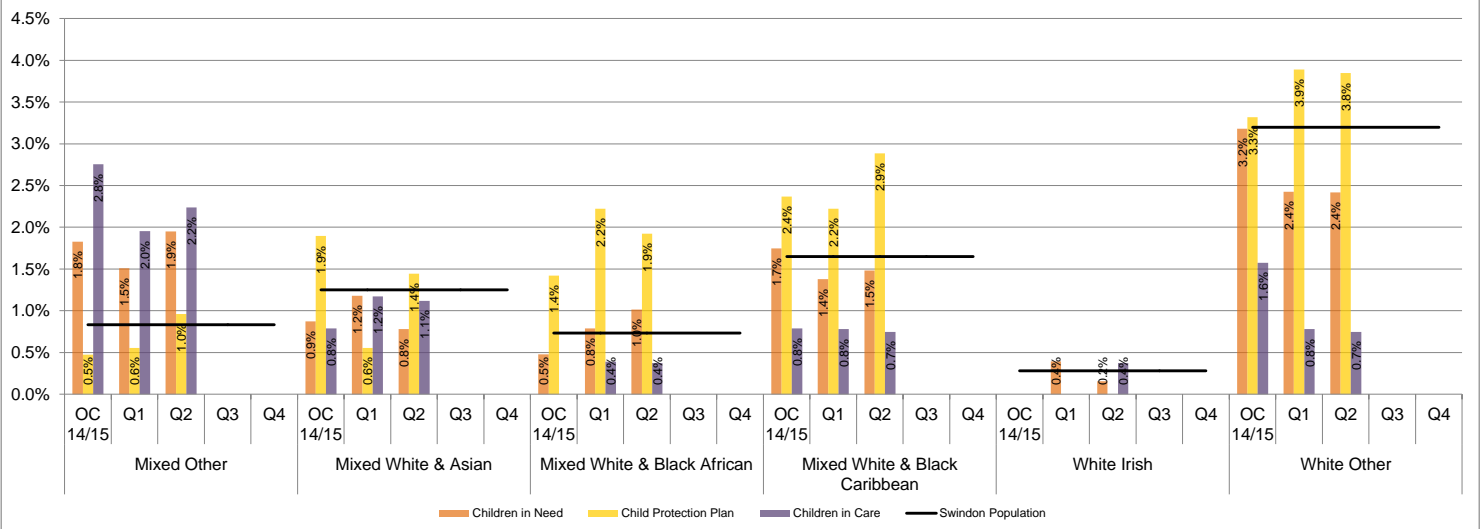
Ethnicity Breakdown 1: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population



Ethnicity Breakdown 2: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population

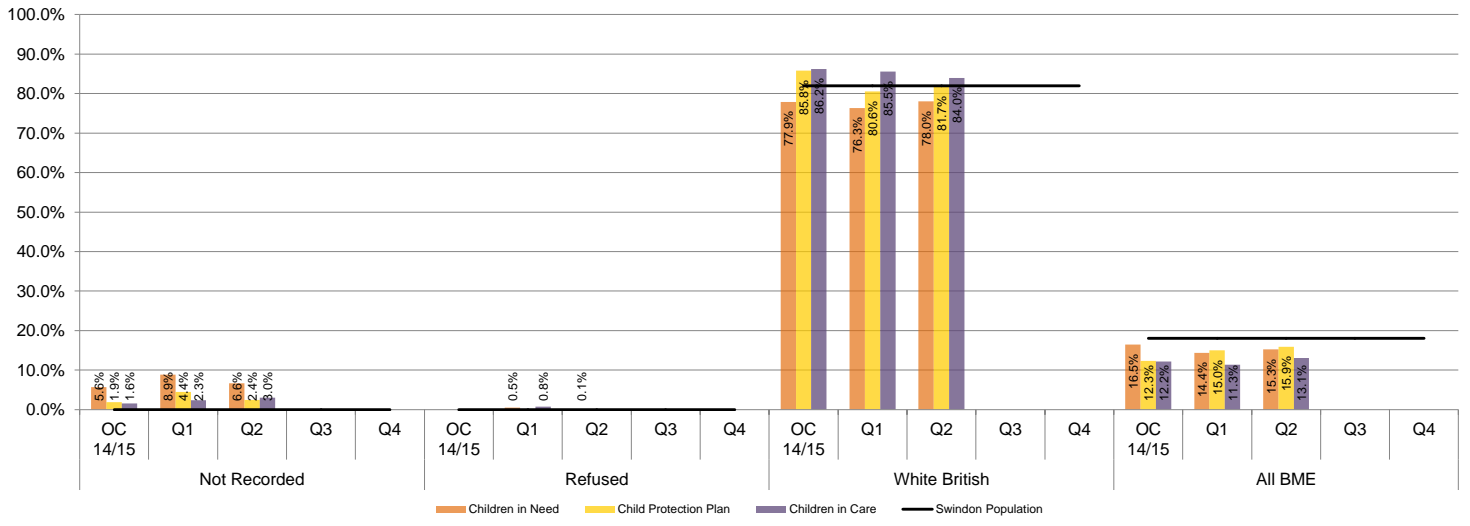


Ethnicity Breakdown 3: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population

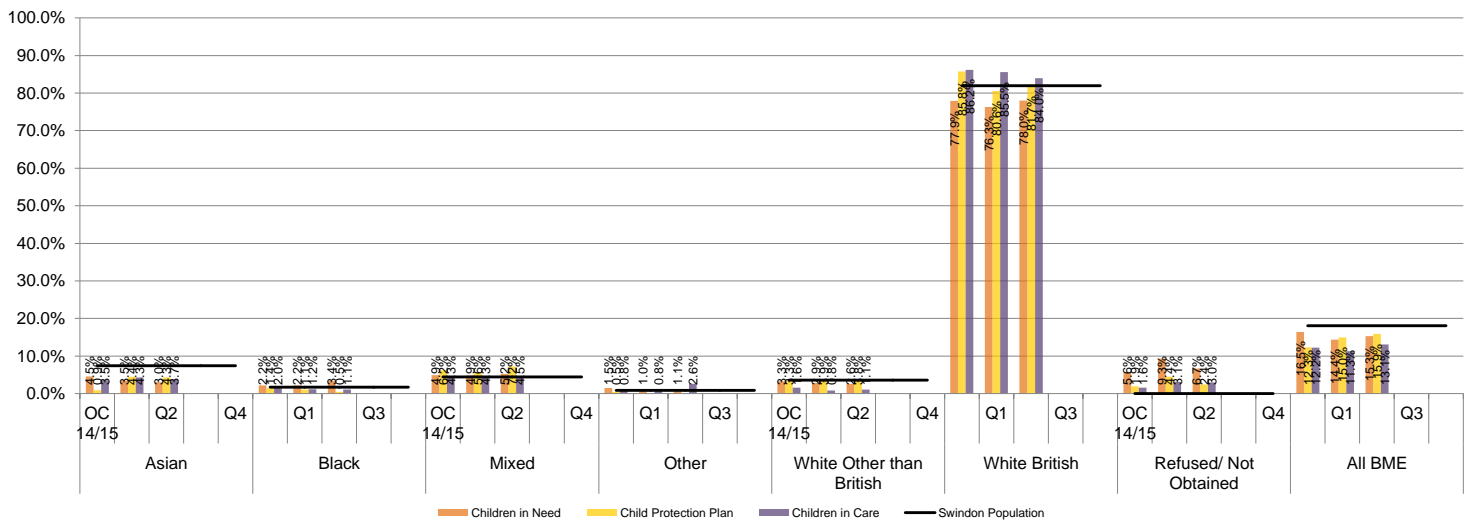

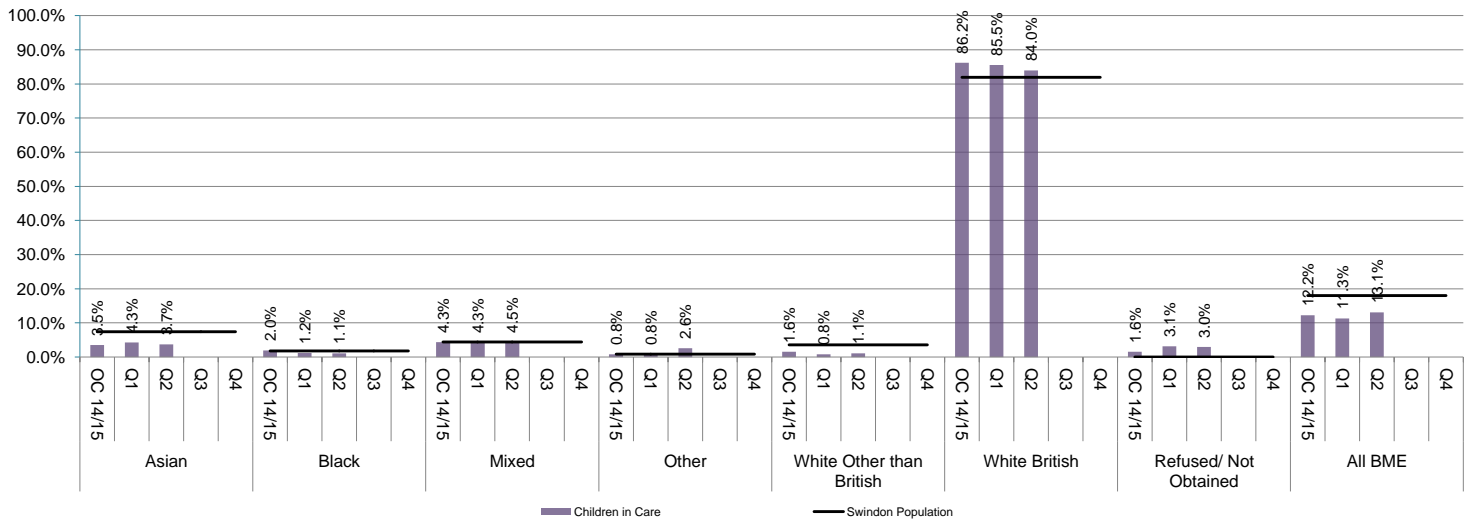
Ethnicity Breakdown 4: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population



Ethnicity Breakdown 5: Open social care cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population



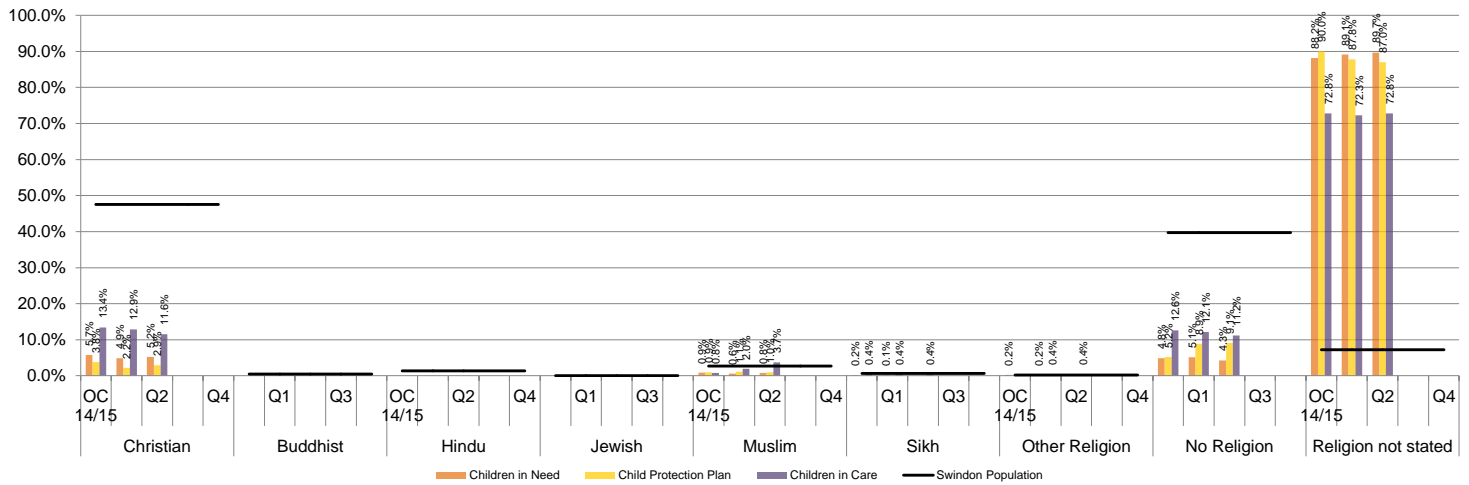
Ethnicity Breakdown 5a: Children in Care open cases, compared with Swindon under 18 population
