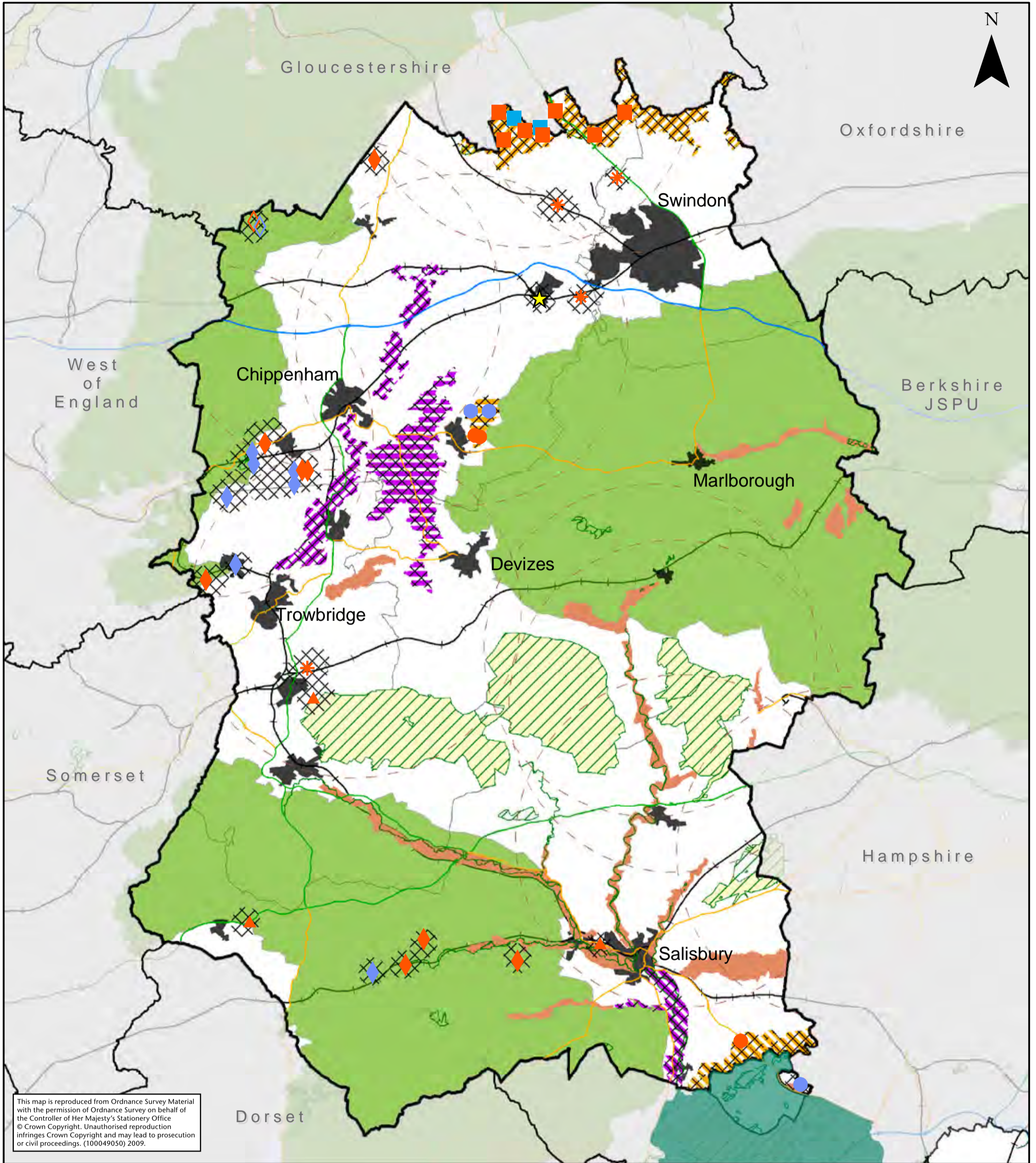


Minerals Core Strategy Key Diagram
