

NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

FOOTPATH LN12 ORDER 2017

The above order, made on 5 July 2017, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpath in the parish of Liddington, running from point A at OS grid reference SU19224 81996, at the southern perimeter of the Great Western Hospital grounds and 40 metres west of the northbound exit slip road of the A419 trunk road, leading east-northeast for 30 metres, north for 20 metres, and east for 10 metres to point Z at OS grid reference SU19258 82003, at the slip road, immediately south of the emergency entrance to the hospital grounds, to a line running from point A at OS grid reference SU19224 81996, at the southern perimeter of the Great Western Hospital grounds and 40 metres west of the northbound exit slip road of the A419 trunk road, leading south for 350 metres to point B at OS grid reference SU19218 81689 at the parish boundary, continuing south then west to point C, north to point D and generally west-southwest to point E at OS grid reference SU18967 81588 at Day House Lane, south of Badbury Wick, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at The One Stop Shop, Beckhampton Street, Swindon from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £15.00.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing, addressed to the Rights of Way Officer, Swindon Borough Council, Wat Tyler House West, Beckhampton Street, Swindon, SN1 2JH, not later than 4 August 2017. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Swindon Borough Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
