ORDER 2020

On 18 November 2020 Swindon Borough Council confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish part of the length, and the full width, of the public footpath from Point A at OS grid reference SU18308669, the junction with Watermead, running in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 265 metres to OS grid reference SU18458683, then in generally south easterly direction for approximately 190 metres to OS grid reference SU18588669 and then in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 130 metres to Point B at OS grid reference SU18688676, the junction with the private road at Keypoint, a total distance of approximately 585 metres, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map may be seen free of charge at the Customer Services Reception, Wat Tyler House, Princes Street, Swindon, SN1 2JG, from 9am to 5pm on Mondays and Wednesdays to Fridays and 9am to 4pm on Tuesdays. The order came into force on 30 December 2020 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 42 days from 22 January 2021 make an application to the High Court.
