## Summary of the representations submitted to the independent Examiner

The Draft Stratton St Margaret Neighbourhood Plan was published and consulted on by Swindon Borough Council on 13th November 2019 - 3rd January 2019.

- Opportunity to identify barriers to active travel

- Evidence base regarding burial space
- New proposed policy on new waste water infrastructure
- SuDS and flood risk mitigation
- Proposed water efficiency policy
