Good morning

I write to express my concern that the above footpath has not been correctly reinstated to the route it had previously followed for many years and originally supported by WPC

Our family moved from Kite Hill to Burycroft in 1993 and had regularly used the footpath to enable a safe route between Burycroft and The Marsh to avoid what has become increasingly busier with not just local farm and residents traffic but also commuters using the road as a cut through

The footpath was accessed by a stile/gate on the south side and exited through a gate way direct onto Wrightsbridge drive close to the sharp bend on The Marsh lane. When our children were young they loved to watch Mr Sadlers ducks and moorhens on the pond through the mesh wire fence at the side of the footpath

Whilst I am very pleased the footpath across Honeyfield Farm has been correctly acknowledged and confirmed - again another path used by our family - I urge you to support the reinstatement of this footpath to the former route to enable and ensure a safe way for villagers to negotiate the Burycroft/Marsh lane
