Please see my comments below

In the early 90's there was a five bar gate and stile, leading from the caravan park. From the Ducksbridge direction the stile was to the right of the five bar gate, and coming from Wrightsbridge to the left.

The five bar gate was mostly locked, and was opened only for the occasional use for the tractor (by Gerald Sadler, previous owner) to access the field opposite (now known as Honeyfield).

In the early 2000's the stile fell into disrepair, and was never fixed, thus leaving a gap to one side of the five bar gate, which you could walk straight through, this remained in use until the site was acquired for Development.

During March to July 2001 (whilst on Maternity leave) I walked this route most days from my house (Marsh Bungalow) to go to my Parents house in the High Street.
