2. The footpath as shown on the order map from Point G at The Marsh, Wanborough, at OS grid reference SU20338372 to Point D at the above footpath at OS grid reference SU20338372.

The effect of the proposed modification would be to modify the Order by providing for the following modification:-

• From the Order and the Order plan, delete all reference to the route shown between Points A-B-C-D

The Inspector can only consider whether the action of the relevant landowners and users has led to a right of way being established on the land in question.
