FOOTPATH 44 WANBOROUGH MODIFICATION ORDER 2017**

This Order is made by Swindon Borough Council ("the authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Highworth Rural District Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

Swindon Borough Council hereby orders that:

- 1 For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 21 June 2017.
- 2 The Highworth Rural District Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3 This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Swindon Borough Council Footpath 44 Wanborough Modification Order 2017.

#### MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

(References to lettered points in the following descriptions are references to letters on the attached maps showing the paths or ways being described. All distances are approximate. All descriptions are of "footpaths" unless otherwise stated)

Wanborough	44	<p>A length of path which commences at path 25 at OS grid reference SU20408371, at Suters Lane, 35 metres north west of Burycroft (Point A) and leads generally north west <del>and westerly for 30 metres to Point B at OS grid reference SU20388372, continuing west north west for 40 metres</del> <b>for 72 metres</b> to Point C at OS grid reference SU20338373, continuing <del>west for 7 metres</del> <b>north westerly for 10 metres</b> through Point D to Point E at OS grid reference SU20338373 and continuing north west for a further 110 metres to Point F at OS grid reference SU20268382, having a width <b>varying from 4 metres to 10 metres between Points A and C as shown cross hatched red on the Order Map</b> and a width of 3 metres between <del>Points A and B and</del> Points C, D, E and F, <del>and a width of 1.2 metres between Points B and C with a field gate, gap and stile at Point C and</del> a stile at Point E as shown on the Order Map.</p> <p>A length of path which commences at The Marsh at OS grid reference SU20338372 and leads generally north for 10 metres to Point D at OS grid reference SU20338373 having a width of 3 metres as shown on the Order Map.</p>	53(3)(c)(i)

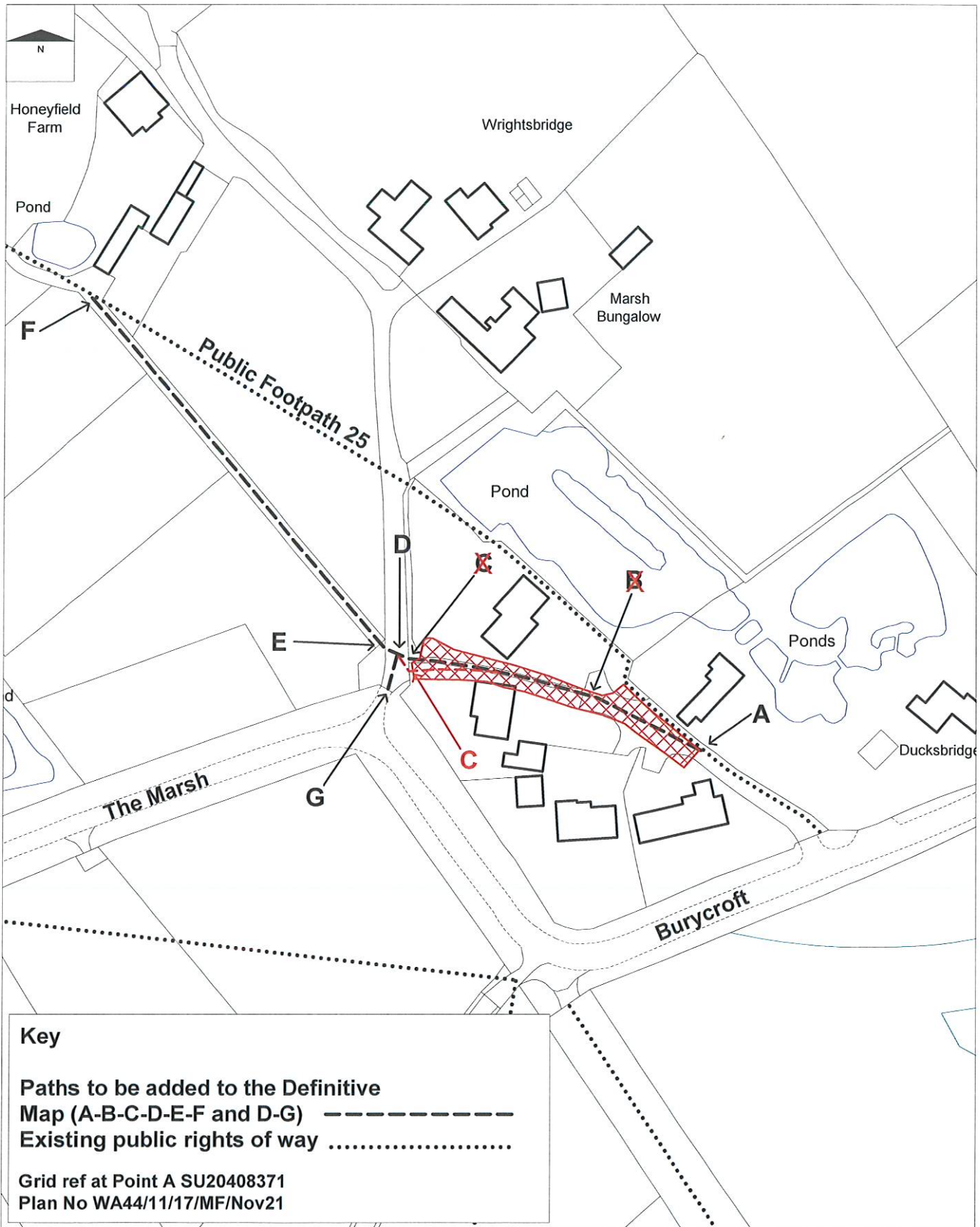

### MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

#### VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH

Parish	Path no.	Statement
Wanborough	44	<p>The new description of this path shall be:</p> <p><u>FOOTPATH:</u> From Suters Lane, Public Footpath 25, leading north west and westerly for 72m <del>30m</del> with a width varying from 4 metres to 10 metres as shown cross hatched red on the Order Map of 3m and continuing west north west for 40m, with a width of 1.2m to a field gate, gap and stile and the access road to Honeyfield Farm. The path continues north west across the access road to a stile and then north west for a distance of <del>417m</del> 119m with a width of 3m to rejoin Public Footpath 25. A short spur leads north from The Marsh along the access road to Honeyfield Farm for 10m with a width of 3m to join the above path.</p> <p>Length: <del>487m</del> 191m + 10m spur Width: <del>1.2m 3m</del> 3m – 10m</p>
