

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**  
**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257**  
**AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14**  
**SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**PUBLIC FOOTPATH 12, PARISH OF LIDDINGTON**  
**ORDER 2022**

On 30 November 2022 Swindon Borough Council confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed will be to divert the public footpath running from Point A at OS grid reference SU18898217, approximately 8 metres west of Coateside Way, in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 77 metres to Point B at OS grid reference SU18928209, approximately 60 metres from the centre of the helipad and create the alternative footpath, to be known as Footpath 12 in the Parish of Liddington and Footpath 60 in the Parish of Central Swindon South, from Point A, running in a generally west south westerly direction across the parish boundary then turning in a generally south south easterly direction to pass through Point C, and, then turning in a generally east north easterly direction across the parish boundary to Point B, a total distance of approximately 115 metres, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order and the map may be seen free of charge at the One Stop Shop, Wat Tyler House, Beckhampton Street, Swindon, from 9am to 5pm on Mondays and Wednesdays to Fridays and 9am to 4pm on Tuesdays. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £15. The order and order map can also be viewed on the public rights of way pages of the Swindon Borough Council website ([www.swindon.gov.uk/publicpathorders](http://www.swindon.gov.uk/publicpathorders)).

The order came into force on the 2 December 2022 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 8 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 8 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
