Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2021 (Variation No 8) Order 2023

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following a request from developers as part of their S278 agreement for Woodland View, Wroughton, this Order seeks to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time),

The request is as a consequence of visibility concerns due to parked vehicles on Woodland View.

Therefore, to address the concerns raised Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and recommends the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time

The reasons for making this order are as follows;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians),
- c. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs,
- d. to assist with the free flow of traffic,
- e. to improve the environment for local residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with residents and emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
