The new Local Offer change request form

Changes happen all the time. The Local Offer change form allows us to develop, amend and update pages on the Local Offer as quickly and as efficiently as possible, keeping ahead of any changes that may occur to your service area.

We have updated the form to include questions that allow us to capture more information from you resulting in a much quicker and more efficient process. Changes include questions like:

- Are you the page owner? If you own the page this allows us to continue working with you to complete the changes requested rather than stopping to check with the page owner if we can proceed.
- Has the page been updated recently? It is important that the Local Offer is kept up to date, so even if you are making a small change on the page please review the whole page to ensure all the information is up to date.
- Have you read the Local Offer Content Style Guidelines? You might not be aware that there is help on the Local Offer to help you write content. It gives you tips on content style, use of acronyms and abbreviations, tone of voice and much more. You can view the style guidelines here.
- Have you created a video? In order to ensure that the Local Offer is as accessible as possible we would ask that before submitting a video that you also provide a transcript to that video. This allows people with various needs and abilities to access the information on the video.
