Aiming High

Many children and young people with disabilities will be able to access the range of groups and activities available

in this summer edition of News Splash. Reasonable adjustments should be made to ensure that children and young people with disabilities receive the same service, as far as this is possible, as those without disabilities.

Inclusion Funding is available through Aiming High for children and young people who would be unable to access community groups and activities despite reasonable adjustments, and require additional support to do so. Inclusion Funding is provided directly to the community group or activity provider to employ additional staff so that the child or young person can access the activity.

Referrals for Inclusion Funding can be made via the <u>SBC</u> website (https://www.swindon.gov.uk/xfp/form/720). If you are unable to refer online, contact Aiming High via <u>AimingHigh@swindon.gov.uk</u> or 01793 464080. Referrals are accepted from parents, carers or anyone working with the child, including the community group or activity provider.

We recognise that some children will be unable to access community groups and activities even with additional support provided through Inclusion Funding. Please contact Aiming High to discuss specialist services.

The <u>Summer Reading Challenge</u>, which encourages children to read for pleasure over the summer holidays, starts Saturday 8th July and runs until Saturday 9th September. This year's Summer Reading Challenge launches with a free, family activity event on Saturday 8th July at Central Library from 10.30 – 13.30. With this year's Challenge theme of 'Ready, Set, Read' which links reading with sport and games, <u>the launch event</u> includes lots of fun, free activities for children to try.

Swindon Libraries' Children's Patron, the award-winning writer and illustrator, Steve Antony is officially opening the launch with help from local children. Children can try circus skills with local events company Fandangos.





Let's Ride Swindon is running a <u>five mile guided bike ride</u> of the local area using quiet streets and traffic-free cycle paths. There will be a Smoothie Bike, where children pedal to power a blender and make their own fruit smoothies. Plus lots of games and sporty activities to try.

Outside of the library and aimed at younger children, Swindon Library Service has created a Family Story Trail in Queen's Park, which runs until the end of July.

For children who are more creative than active, there will be a Creation Station where, among other things, children can design their own 'Swinpup' – linking in with the <u>Big Dog Art</u> <u>Trail</u> puppy sculptures libraries will be hosting from 15th July. Each of the five Council Libraries will have a Creation Station for the duration of the Summer Reading Challenge.




As well as enjoying the free activities, children can register to take part in the Summer Reading Challenge. As an incentive, the first 100 children to register for the Challenge at the launch event will receive a free mini Frisbee and a free book. Plus their free Summer Reading Challenge pack which they'll need to take part.

To support children with SEND to engage with the Summer Reading Challenge, particularly those with more profound learning and physical needs, <u>Swindon Stories</u>, in collaboration with Swindon SEND Families Voice, has created a <u>free activities sheet</u>.

There will also be two free, <u>Interactive Storyteller events for children with SEND</u>. The first at North Swindon Library on Tuesday 8th August from 11am - 12.30pm. And the second at West Swindon Library on Tuesday 15th August from 3pm - 4.30pm. Places must be booked, with online bookings opening three weeks before the event.
