# GOOD PRACTICE STORY BOARD COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions



#### 1. What are we improving?

In March 2020 the country went into a national lockdown period as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Schools and educational settings were closed to the majority of pupils and parents were left to home educate their children, whilst also juggling other commitments such as working from home. This was a very challenging period of time for families and especially for parents/carers of children with SEND. The information coming from the government changed regularly and this often leaving parents feeling bewildered and confused.

Coproduction between SSFV, CCG and SBC began to keep families up to date with developments relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, both nationally and with regards to SEND provision locally. The multiagency response included SSFV collating frequently asked questions (FAQs) from families and working with SBC and the CCG to ensure that these were answered quickly and clearly and made available publically by being posted onto the Local Offer website.
