

**Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places
Consolidation) Order 2021 (Variation No 36) Order 2023**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following requests from Business users within the local area, this order seeks to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time),

The requests are as a consequence of parking and visibility difficulties encountered on Brindley Close as a result of parked vehicles

Therefore to address the concerns raised Swindon Borough Council proposes to introduce a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and recommends the introduction of No Waiting at Any Time

The reason for making this order is as follow;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
or
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- c. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs, or
- d. to assist with the free flow of traffic,
- e. to improve the environment for local Businesses/residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with residents and emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
