Copy Cats

Name an action and ask your child to copy you. Take turns to name an action to copy. *E.g. touch your toes, clap hands, turn around, stand up, wiggle your fingers, tap the table.*

Try some of these activities when you're out in the countryside, at a café, in a gallery, at a market...



Collecting

Give your child a list of things to find/collect. If possible prepare pictures, otherwise just tell them 1-3 things at a time depending on their age/memory.

Phone Home

Use a real/toy/imaginary phone. Choose who you will phone. Take turns pretending to tell this person what you're doing/ have done. *E.g. "We had breakfast. I had Cornflakes. We're at the park"*



Find things that...

- are red
- are cold
- grow
- have a tail
- to put on bread
- are circle shaped

Take turns to find something of that description, or specify the number of things to find.
