Look out for more at different places around Swindon.

Try some of these activities when you're in the garden, in a plane, at the pool, having a picnic...

## Sing a song

Take turns to choose a song to sing to pass the time. Can you change the words to match the situation? *E.g. Old MacDonal'd had a park; This is the way we mow the lawn...*



## Keep the Beat

Choose an action to do (E.g. stamping, jumping, shaking keys, waving). Clap/tap a beat for your child to do the action in time to. Take turns to change the action.

## Can you see a...

Keep your child busy with things to look for. Try making it into a competition. *E.g. first one to see a car; pushchair; dog; traffic lights; hat; tractor.*



## Yes versus no!

Choose a category / opposites and use these to describe things you see. *E.g. healthy/not healthy; grows/doesn't grow; bigger than me/not bigger*
