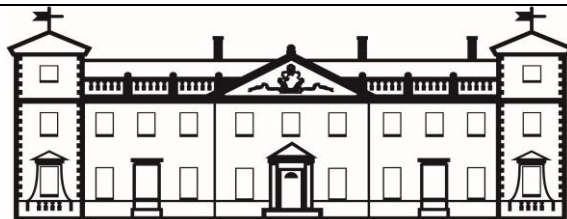


Barbecue Hire at Lydiard Park 2021/22

Terms and Conditions



Lydiard Park

1. Your payment is non-refundable.
2. If you do not turn up on the day of your booking, your booking will be lost.
3. If you need to rearrange your BBQ, or cancel due to bad weather, please inform us by telephone at least three days before your booking. Failure to do this will result in the loss of your booking. We can transfer the booking to an alternative date within the current BBQ season, subject to availability. 01793 464644
You must contact us within five days of the cancellation to rearrange your BBQ or your booking will be lost.
4. If an alternative suitable date cannot be accommodated within the current BBQ season, we will reschedule your BBQ to the following year's BBQ season.
5. Your booking is for a BBQ only. Please bring your own coals, food and cooking utensils.
6. You are welcome to bring your own picnic chairs and one small gazebo (maximum size 3m x 3m).
7. Please do not bring bouncy castles, other inflatables, ball pits, soft play items, large gazebos, marquees, or gas/disposable BBQs, as these are not permitted in the Park.
8. Please do not play loud music, which may disturb other Park users.
9. We welcome dogs to the Park. However, from 1st April to 30th September please ensure that your dog is on a lead in designated areas, as a public protection order is active between these dates.
10. BBQs must be supervised by a responsible adult aged 21 or over at all times. Groups of people under 16 years of age are not allowed to use our BBQ's unless they have adult supervision
11. The BBQ/picnic area is for the use of all Park visitors. All BBQ users must respect the space and no group/organisation has priority over another.
12. No commercial or charity fundraising events are allowed in the BBQ area. The sale of food or other items is not permitted within the Park.
13. If you are planning a large gathering (e.g. 50 – 100 people), two adjoining BBQ pitches must be hired in order to provide sufficient space for your group and for our other BBQ users. This will be subject to availability. Alternatively, you can hire the private, enclosed St John Hollow, which has a capacity of 150 covers.
14. BBQ sessions for 2021 will be from 12noon until park gate closing time, (dusk), closing times are displayed at park gates. If you are planning an evening only gathering, please ensure you turn up for your booking by 5pm so that the wardens can unlock your BBQ. Call wardens on 07766 368262.
15. BBQ hirers are responsible for clearing all litter from their pitch on departure. We ask that you take litter home with you, or place it in the large metal bins provided on the perimeter of the field. Confetti and party streamers are not permitted in the Park. A fee of £50 will be charged for any litter clearance that has to be undertaken by the Estate & Parkland Team following your BBQ.
